Prior to this date, information regarding nominees can be obtained from the Returning Officer. Please be advised that the College cannot accept any responsibility for late mail deliveries.

Candidates are invited to submit a photograph and personal statement of up to a (*strictly enforced*) limit of 250 words that will be forwarded to eligible voters when voting links are distributed by email. The final version of the statement and photograph must reach the Returning Officer by no later that **midnight on Monday 3rd March**.

As a guide to best practise, candidates will be emailed copies of personal statements and photos from past elections. The preferred form of the personal statement is an emailed document in ".docx" format (i.e. an emailed *Word* document, although ".doc", ".rtf" or ".txt" are also fine, as is a hard copy, or text in the body of an email). The photo should be in ".jpeg" format, preferably with a file size of 0.15 Mb to at most 5 Mb. The photo should have and aspect ratio (i.e. width to height ratio) of 1:1 i.e. approximately square. **Please send the statement and photo as separate attachments.**
